Vaccination requirements for kenneling:

<u>Dogs</u>: Annual 5-in-1, Rabies and <u>KENNEL COUGH</u> vaccinations up to date and cover the boarding period or <u>must be completed no less than two weeks before arrival date.</u>

**Please note that the KENNEL COUGH vaccination is <u>not</u> included in the standard annual vaccinations and must be specifically requested at the vet.

Please see below our policy regarding the different types of <u>Kennel Cough vaccines</u> and each of <u>our specific requirements</u> for each. Accommodation will be refused if incorrectly vaccinated or not in the correct time frames for the specific vaccine.

KENNEL COUGH VACCINES;

*Bronchicine (Injectable):

First time or expired vaccination(over 12 mnths):

2 doses with an interval of 2 – 4 weeks. Will only accept dogs after 2nd vaccine.

Reinforcement: 1 annual dose.

*Nobivac KC (Intra-nasal):

First vaccination: 1 dose no less than 72 hours prior to

boarding.

Reinforcement: 1 annual dose

*Pneumodog (Injectable):

First time or expired vaccination(over 12 mnths):

2 doses with an interval of 2-4 weeks. Will only accept dogs after 2^{nd} vaccine.

Reinforcement: 1 annual dose.

LABELS THAT WOULD BE IN YOUR VET BOOK FOR KC



<u>Pneumodog:</u> First vaccination or if older than 12 months: 2 doses, 2-4 weeks apart. We will only accept dogs after 2nd vaccine

Reinforcement: 1 dose annually



Bronchicine: First vaccination or if older than 12 months: 2 doses 2-4 weeks apart. We will only accept dogs after 2nd vaccine

Reinforcement: 1 dose annually



Nobivac KC – Intra-nasal: First vaccination: 1 dose no less than 72 hours Prior to boarding.

Reinforcement: 1 dose annually
