

Vaccination requirements for kenneling:

Dogs: Annual 5-in-1, Rabies and **KENNEL COUGH** vaccinations up to date and cover the boarding period or must be completed no less than two weeks before arrival date.

**Please note that the KENNEL COUGH vaccination is not included in the standard annual vaccinations and must be specifically requested at the vet.

Please see below our policy regarding the different types of Kennel Cough vaccines and each of our specific requirements for each. Accommodation will be refused if incorrectly vaccinated or not in the correct time frames for the specific vaccine.

KENNEL COUGH VACCINES:

***Bronchicine (Injectable):**

First time or expired vaccination(over 12 mnths):

2 doses with an interval of 2 – 4 weeks. Will only accept dogs after 2nd vaccine.

Reinforcement: 1 annual dose.

***Nobivac KC (Intra-nasal):**

First vaccination: 1 dose no less than 72 hours prior to boarding.

Reinforcement: 1 annual dose

***Pneumodog (Injectable):**

First time or expired vaccination(over 12 mnths):

2 doses with an interval of 2 – 4 weeks. Will only accept dogs after 2nd vaccine.

Reinforcement: 1 annual dose.

LABELS THAT WOULD BE IN YOUR VET BOOK FOR KC



Pneumodog: First vaccination or if older than 12 months: 2 doses, 2-4 weeks apart. We will only accept dogs after 2nd vaccine

Reinforcement: 1 dose annually



Bronchicine: First vaccination or if older than 12 months: 2 doses 2-4 weeks apart. We will only accept dogs after 2nd vaccine

Reinforcement: 1 dose annually



Nobivac KC – Intra-nasal: First vaccination: 1 dose no less than 72 hours Prior to boarding.

Reinforcement: 1 dose annually
